To the Leelanau County Board of Commissioners:

I was listening to your executive board meeting last Tuesday and was shocked to hear that you voted to lower the millage supporting the Early Childhood program to .000. Raising children in today's world is challenging, especially during a pandemic. Providing support for families is the right thing to do.

I have concerns about Chairman Bunek's comments last Tuesday. I went back and listened to his remarks a number of times. He said that "when people make a wrong decision (at the polls) we're (BOC) to make sure that it doesn't go on. Commissioner Allgaier asked him to clarify what he meant by that statement. She asked if he meant that "if a public vote is taken and it's wrong, it is our duty to nullify it." He said yes, that is what he meant. Wow! Why do we even vote, then?
