HI All, apologies for the delay in this but please see attached Myles Kimmerly draft master plan layout updates.

The overall plan illustrates the major elements discussed in our initial meeting. I have a few options for pickleball and parking area, which are mainly to show you potential configuration options and elements to scale (goal in this area was to create 55-60 parking spaces and 6-8 pickleball courts).

There is more thought into this than what is shown on the sheets and I would like the chance to review these plans with you. I would hope we could make and incorporate any comments, and work up a good layout for public comment. If possible I can meet at your earliest convenience, virtual or in person works for me.

I would like to render/color this layout only one time, so maybe this happens after public comment so final updates can be made prior to rendering a final draft.

A few of my running notes/thoughts/questions I would plan to discuss with you are:

- Formalize overflow parking areas with fencing delineation? Gravel?
- Improved or New Disc Golf Kiosk, same location? Formalize a disc golf starting area??
- Show trail network to the south?
- Please provide layout for disc golf warm up course
- Show existing disc golf course layout?
- Accessible route to accessible restroom enclosures north of parking. Provide separate accessible parking spots this area?
- Accessible route to NE restroom enclosures from parking area?
- Show dog park?
- Final rendering Size/Layout/Format Focus on main park area or should this encompass entire southern disc golf area?

Thank you again, please let me know if you would like to proceeded with a design review meeting/discussion/mark up, or if you have any questions in the meantime. Thank you much!

Hi Laurel! Thanks for reaching out and sorry for the delayed response.

Yes it has been an extremely busy summer for us, but good that we are staying busy!

I am finishing up this week with a first draft (linework over aerial imagery) of the Myles Kimmerly park master plan graphic, that would include the desired project elements discussed in our initial site walk through. I'll try to get this out by week's end for review.

There are a couple of options for review process of the first draft after I send it out:

1. Myles Kimmerly Park committee could mark up provided first draft plan and generate comment themselves (all individual comments summarized), then send to me for review and update the plan appropriately.

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2. After I send draft out this week, we could set up a meeting/work session in a couple/few weeks for me to meet up there with the Myles Kimmerly Park committee to review the first draft and comments in person (this may expedite the process and prevent more back and forth).

I think that option 2 might work best so we can all discuss the proposed plan components, and then I could bring back the comments and update the plan accordingly. Not sure if this would happen as a quick work session at a formal Myles Kimmerly committee meeting? Or at an intermediate project specific meeting.

Any thoughts, we would be happy to accommodate whichever review process you think would be best. Thanks again Laurel!


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MYLES KIMMERLY PARK - MASTER PLAN UPDATE
OVERALL LAYOUT










LAYOUT C - PARKING/PICKLEBALL AREA

#### Good Morning,


I wanted to reach out to provide a few thoughts regarding future updates to Myles Kimmerly, and hope you will share with the full parks and rec committee. I am in complete agreement that the number one priority should be upgrading bathroom facilities. A fully plumbed building would be ideal, but anything would be better than the current setup.

I would also encourage the committee to strongly consider upgrades to the baseball fields as a higher priority. As a coach of several little league teams, I would love to see the outfields leveled, and install grass/irrigation to match the soccer fields. Permanent 200 ft fences on two fields would allow for not only little league tournaments to be held, but also high school and adult softball tournaments. I also coach middle school softball for Glen Lake, and we could potentially have 4 softball and 4 baseball teams this spring (2 MS and 2 HS each), and having access to additional quality fields would be critical for the programs. The outfields could also be used for pop warner football in the fall. Other upgrades to consider are scoreboards (electric or manual), and refreshed dugouts. I would gladly be involved in the process of developing partnerships with these organizations to assist with increased maintenance needs, financially or in-kind.

Thank you for all the work you have done in making Myles Kimmerly one of the nicest parks in the region. With a few upgrades, I think it could be the nicest in the state, and it would continue to draw athletic teams of all levels from all over the country for practices and exhibitions, which is a huge bonus for our local kids to be able to watch these events so close to home.
