Influent readings for March are not available at this time.

The lagoon level is within normal operational levels for this time of year.

Effluent flows are being maintained to keep a minimum lagoon level around 10'.

### HYDROGEN SULFIDE CONTROL PROJECT

- 2022 extension of pilot study underway materials being ordered.
- Meeting held with Harbormaster on placement of equipment.
- Engineering proposal for permanent installation.

### RIVER STREET GRAVITY SEWER

- · Preliminary Plans received from Gosling Czubak.
- Work needs to be coordinated with the Carlson Fishery building project.
- Coordination meetings involving Harbor, Fishtown, Road Commission and business owners will be held.

### ON-GOING SCHEDULED PROJECTS / MAINTENANCE / REPAIRS

- Influent flowmeter ordered and will be installed by IAI.
- Up-coming work:
  - Duck Lake Road Lift Station Work being scheduled to fix pump seal.
  - Thompson Street Lift Station Work being scheduled to fix pump seal. Plans to modify the bottom of the station in order to replace the pump rails and seats.
  - WWTP Dosing Station rebuild is completed.
  - One WWTP lagoon aerator is being re-built by IAI. Two others in need of repair.
  - New Impellers to be installed on the pumps at the Marina Lift Station
  - Two dosing valves at the WWTP to be replaced. (normal replacement)
  - Influent manhole.

#### SEWER OPERATIONS & CALL-OUTS (IAI report)

- Repair of pavement patch at the Leland Merc. no issue found.
- Phosphorous effluent tested at 6 ppm in December, which is down significantly. Goal is 0.5 ppm
- Retest of February monitor well phosphorous results/
- STEP pump at Leland merc.
- STEP pump alarm on West Street probable frozen pipe owner out of town.
- Septic tank pumping as weather allows commercial pumpings.

### **SYSTEM ADMINISTRATION**

- Questions on connections and the sewer system in general, permits & building. Sewer Billings
- Miss Dig staking requests remain steady.
- 3-4 houses under constructions being reviewed and measurements.
- End of March meter readings and billings.
- Working on septic tank pumping list and bidding.
- Working on Capital Improvement Plans with IAI assessment of facilities.
