At a session of said Court held at the Courthouse in the Village of Ieland, in Leelanau County on the 16th day of October, 1978.

Having read the Petition of the Leelanau County Board of Commissioners for a Determination of the Normal Height and Level of the Waters of Lake Leelanau, and for the confirmation of the Special Assessment District, and having heard testimony in support of said Petition, and the Court being further fully advised in the premises, now, therefore,


On Motion of Larry J. Nelson, Prosecuting Attorney for Leelanau County, Michigan, on behalf of Petitioner,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED and this Court by virtue of the authority therein vested and in pursuance of the statute in such case made and provided, does ORDER AND ADJUDGE that a level of 589.21 feet "Mean Sea Level Datum", with a maximum fluctuation of plus 0 inches and minus 2 inches, shall be maintained from April 15 of each year or at ice break-up on said lake, whichever occurs later, until November 15 of each year; on November 15 of each year said lake level shall be reduced to 588.21 feet "Mean Sea Level Datum" until the following April 15 or ice break-up, whichever occurs later at which time it shall be increased to the previous above stated level until further Order of this Court. These levels shall be maintained at the site of the dam located in the Village of Ieland, County of Leelanau, and State of Michigan.

*Dry year - sooner - see how to be gone.*  
*(April 1 or 15) at start up*

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that said set levels are effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the boundaries of a Special Assessment District are hereby confirmed for the above case, said Special Assessment District to consist of all riparian parcels of land on Lake Leelanau, the Cedar River, to the Village of Cedar, the Lake Leelanau Narrows and the Leland River to the site of the dam.
