This is the first of two requests for an upgrade to the Law Enforcement Center's HVAC system, specifically the Sergeant's Office space, which desperately needs an added cooling component, by way of a proposed mini-split system (see attached quote).					
When the remodeled system was designed approximately six years ago, it had been brought to the engineering firm's attention that a separate cooling system was critical; the existing system is not adequate, and at times temperatures reach well above a comfort range for employees within the Sergeant's Room, as they are required to wear a lot of heavy equipment including protective gear.					
The attached quote and correspondence from D&W Mechanical was subsequently requested, as they are the primary firm for HVAC repair and installation of the County's equipment (note: the quote for this request begins after the Computer Room quote.)					
We are requesting the Board approve the project, as the weather begins to heat up.

Hi Laurel,

Please find updated proposal attached for adding cooling units to the Sergeants room and Computer room. I've listed them separately and note each proposal includes everything except the electrical which Gary is capable of doing, and the roof flashing which because the roof is relatively new, any modifications needs to be done by a roofer that's certified with the manufacture as to not void any warranties. Gary was going to get with maintenance to find out who to contact to get this work done and for this reason I have not included the cost in the proposal. Note too that the unit I quoted for the computer room will continue to work even when temperatures outside are below zero, and the unit for the Sargent's room only cools when outdoor temperatures are above zero degrees. I did this because the computer room could need cooling even when it's subzero outside but the Sargent's room should be fine when temperatures outside are below 10 degrees. This is the second of two requests for an upgrade to the Law Enforcement Center's HVAC system, specifically the upper level IT Computer Room, which desperately needs a cooling system added by way of a proposed mini-split system (see attached D&W Mechanical quote).					
When the remodeled system was designed approximately six years ago, this, too, had been brought to the engineering firm's attention attention at that time that a separate cooling system was crucial, as the existing HVAC system is not adequate, and many times temperatures are a cause for concern because of heat damage to the expensive and sophisticated computer systems which could then prematurely break down, and then shut down critical security systems.					
We were planning to request the Board approve this emergency project, as the weather heats up and correcting the situation becomes more urgent, as there is approximately \$1 million in software and hardware systems that need to be protected from premature failure.					
UPDATE: Attached are quotes from both D&W Mechanical and Lutz Roofing. Lutz was contacted because they had installed the roof and we do not want to void the 40-year warranty. Below are two separate recommendations to address this project, as the combined estimate is \$8,881 (\$1,200 to Lutz, and \$7,681 to D&W Mechanical). The D&W quote clarification notes an additional \$395 for a wall-mounted thermostat, which is included within the contracted amount.					
First Recommendation: I move to recommend that the Board of Commissioners waive its bid policy and approve the quote from Lutz Roofing of Shelby Township, Michigan, to provide and install one pitch plan, as presented, in an amount not to exceed \$1,200.00; funds to come from (to be determined).

In addition, avoid "cutting" and opening up the roof overnight. Un-flashed roof penetrations in conjunction with an unexpected precipitation event, can "flood out" the interior space(s) below.
- 17. Our work is "weather" dependent. We can't flash in roof penetration when moisture is present. Please keep in mind that elements of weather when your company is coordinating said work.
