






### Smoke Alarm Program:

Still on hold due to COVID-19

#### Fire-Wise Program:

Still on hold due to Covid-19. Possibly beginning to complete limited, screened, site visits by the spring.

#### Summary:

Our run volume has leveled a bit as it usually does this time of year, but we are still on track to have the busiest year ever for Cedar Area Fire & Rescue.

One major change for the month of November is the North Flight / Mobile Medical Response (MMR) changeover. MMR acquired the North Flight ground division from Munson Healthcare and will now be operating solely as MMR. Solon Township and Kasson Township will primarily see the change as North Flight was the primary ALS intercept provider for those townships. There will be no change in level of care with MMR though because they retained many of the North Flight employees we worked with in the past and bring an experienced staff from their statewide service area.

The Interim Fire Chief transition is continuing smoothly and Chief Comeaux continues to educate me on the duties he fulfilled as Chief.
