Operations Summary:

- Freeboard is within target range
- Waiting for a quote from Mi Agriculture Solutions for lagoon dredging
- All four aerators running as of 1/31/21
- H2S pilot study is in process with weekly sampling.
 - Only Popp and Duck Lake lift stations are showing measurements. Popp lift shows an average of 108ppm with a high of 152ppm and a low of 68ppm. Duck Lake lift shows an average of 33ppm with a high of 50ppm and a low of 25ppm.
- Fire extinguisher inspection completed by Summitt 1/22/21. All fire extinguishers are up to date. The representative recommended a CO2 extinguisher for electrical fires and an ABC extinguisher for the basement. A quote was given for the CO2 extinguisher.
- All other monthly operations performed
