

<p>Continuing in the tradition of past disbursements to the schools, the Leelanau County Substance Abuse Prevention Coalition has promoted healthy alternatives for Leelanau County's youth, and one of those ways is by providing a stipend to the schools that host proms.</p> <p>This year, the Coalition is proposing a stipend of \$1,000 to the following schools to assist with preparation and execution of their respective proms. These schools include Glen Lake, Leland, Northport, Suttons Bay, St. Mary, and the Leelanau School. Additionally, Traverse City West Senior High School has a number of County students, and although TC West had inadvertently been omitted in the recommendation, we are requesting approval of a stipend to them as well.</p> <p>The Coalition had recommended approval of the proposed allocations during its meeting on Friday, April 14, and is submitting this late addition request, even though they have approved the disbursements in previous years.</p>

I move that the County Board of Commissioners approve the request of the Leelanau County Substance Abuse Prevention Coalition to provide a \$1,000.00 stipend to each school to assist with their respective senior proms, as presented; funds to come from #101.100.101.967.019.
