Request to Waive Board Policy on Bid Requirements

The annual Old Settlers Picnic has been a great Leelanau County tradition since 1892. Due to Covid-19, it was canceled in 2020; however, the good news is that the Old Settlers' Picnic Association is willing to sponsor a modified version on Sunday August 1. Due to potential state restrictions related to Covid, the Association cannot take the financial risk of purchasing and serving the food at the annual picnic.

The Association is requesting permission from the County to allow a limited number of food truck vendors (maximum of 4) on a one-time only basis in 2021 to be located at the Old Settlers' Park on August 1, contingent that the food vendors have the required food license and insurance liability policies.

Picnic attendees will also have the option of bringing their own food as part of a "pot-luck" picnic.

Suggested Recommendation: I move that the County Board of Commissioners approves the request of the Old Settlers Picnic Association to allow food truck vendors to serve food at the annual Old Settlers Picnic on Sunday, August 1, 2021, contingent on any vendors meeting all local and state requirements related to food safety, and to provide proof of liability insurance. +
