All Township Clerk's offices will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day for the purpose of registering voters.

SUTTONS BAY-BINGHAM FIRE & RESCUE AUTHORITY FIRE, RESCUE AND AMBULANCE SERVICES MILLAGE INCREASE

Shall the Suttons Bay-Bingham Fire & Rescue Authority impose an increase of up to 3.25 mills (\$3.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value) of the taxable value on all taxable property within the territorial limits of the Authority and levy it for three (3) years, 2020 through 2022 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for equipping, operating and maintaining fire, rescue and ambulance services within the territorial limits of the Authority which will raise an estimated \$1,554,022.12 in 2020?
