I strongly and fully support the formation of a Lake Leelanau Preservation Board. I consider this matter both urgent and critical to our priceless natural resource Lake Leelanau. Lakes are only valuable to communities when they are kept clean and healthy.

Higher property values and thus higher tax revenues will be achieved with the creation of this board to protect all residents of the county This proposal must be acted upon with expediency and urgency. Your vote to approve the formation of this board will fund the continuation of the work that both the Lake Leelanau Lake Association and Leelanau Conservancy in cooperation with the Grand Traverse Band of Ottawa and Chippewa Indians have only begun. It is no longer reasonable or possible for them to fund approximately \$150,000 annually to continue this project. This challenge is simply too big and too important for such small groups to address. We need a long term solution and we need it now. You the BOC can vote tonight through a majority vote to approve the formation of this board as a first step toward preserving the lake for future generations to come. Not doing so will jeopardize the revenue from tourism as well as property taxes.
