This letter will be brief as I am composing it on my phone during my lunch break. I am a registered nurse at Munson medical center in Traverse City. I'm also a mother of three kids who attend public schools in the area.

I am alarmed that any school or BOC would even consider, at this point in the pandemic, allowing masks to be optional in schools, or challenging a health department order, especially in schools where the majority of students are unable to be vaccinated. The health department has made a sound judgement in ordering masking in schools where community spread is substantial. The order will minimize spread, protect the vulnerable, and allow schools to stay open. If you were waiting for a sanctity of life issue to come before you, this would be it. Masks save lives.
