

Hazard Mitigation Plan Adoption Resolution

(Resolution No. 2009-01)

Whereas **Centerville Township**, Michigan has experienced risks that may damage commercial, residential and public properties, displace citizens and businesses, close streets and impair infrastructure, and present general public health and safety concerns; and

Whereas the community has prepared a *Hazard Mitigation Plan* that outlines the community's options to reduce overall damage and impact from natural and technological hazards; and

Whereas the *Hazard Mitigation Plan* has been reviewed by community residents, business owners, and federal, state and local agencies, and has been revised to reflect their concerns;

Whereas the Natural All-Hazards Mitigation Plan for Centerville Township, Michigan shall provide the framework for use in reducing loss of life, injuries and property damage related to any disaster either natural or technological, and

Whereas, the Plan is prepared in accordance with 44 CFR Part 210, as authorized by the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, and

Whereas, Centerville Township desires to adopt the plan as written and approved by the Leelanau County Board of Commissioners on August 21st, 2007 as RESOLUTION # 2007-020 and referenced as their Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan,

Now, therefore, be it resolved that Centerville Township Board adopts the Natural Hazards Mitigation plan.

The *Hazard Mitigation Plan* is hereby adopted as an official plan of the
