RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AMBULANCE FINANCING
BY CEDAR AREA FIRE & RESCUE

At the regular meeting of the Centerville Township Board, Leelanau County, Michigan, held on the 14th day of November, 2018.

WHEREAS, Cedar Area Fire & Rescue wishes to apply for financing for an ambulance, and

WHEREAS, Cedar Area Fire & Rescue is required, through the Interlocal Fire Department Agreement, to gain approval from each of the four participating township boards before borrowing funds or entering into an agreement for installment payments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Centerville Township Board does hereby formally approve allowing Cedar Area Fire & Rescue to pursue the borrowing of funds from Cherryland Electric at 0% financing, over a 10 year period, for the purpose of purchasing an ambulance in FY 2018/2019 or 2019/2020, for a total amount not to exceed \$190,000.

The CENTERVILLE TOWNSHIP BOARD MOVED to support the adoption of the foregoing resolution, which was adopted on November 14, 2018, at the regular meeting of the Centerville Township Board, Leelanau County, Michigan.
