

The following extemporaneous comments made from notes taken during the above meeting at the (2nd) Second Public Comment Period during the meeting to the best of our recollection and ability.

- I. **Scheduling for meetings.** NLMCHA person waiting for **5 hours** to make a 3 minute presentation. A waste of time. Our Commissioners appear to have too many underemployed over-compensated people in most of our County's bureaucratic organizations to be able to waste so much time...
- II. **Clerk-Loathing BOC decision fiasco** on May 11, 2021 harming taxpayers and employees in county building, **not on today's meetings Agenda**. Why? Commissioners/Commission apparently "chose" **not be held accountable** per Oath of Office. And, apparently Commissioners/Commission "chose" to neglect to perform their/its Fiduciary Duty/Obligation. The costs to taxpayers for this BOC 5/11/21 uncharitable fiasco will be more than \$500,000 (and ongoing) and negatively impact an elected official's and some employees' the rest of their lives.
- III. **Peculiar/Questionable interview process for New Finance Director.** It seems the Clerk had been denied the opportunity by the Commission and/or the Administrator to interview this applicant. Also, County auditors were left out of the process. Further, it seems odd that **this candidate** "chose" not to request an interview with the person now responsible for County Finances with whom frequent interaction is and will apparently be necessary. Appearances seem to indicate this/these Commission/Commissioners may have set the stage for a REPEAT of the May, 2021 fiasco. This seemingly flawed 'process', per my many years of experience in the private sector appears is unacceptable. To me, this Commission lacks integrity.
I apologize to The People/Taxpayers for this apparent inadequacy.
It seems that Commissioners, (like the past) have adopted a odd modus operandi in this matter: "damn the torpedos, full steam ahead", no matter the cost to TAXPAYERS and harm and damage to people...
