BE IT RESOLVED, that as of April 1, 2022, the salary of the township supervisor shall be submitted as \$26,000

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be submitted to the electors at the annual meeting to be held on March 19, 2022, at which time the electors may modify this amount. Pursuant to MCL 41.95, such modification that may be made by the electors cannot result in a reduction in salary during the official's term of office. In the event that the electors fail to act on this resolution, the official shall be entitled to the salary as established in this resolution, in accordance with state law.


