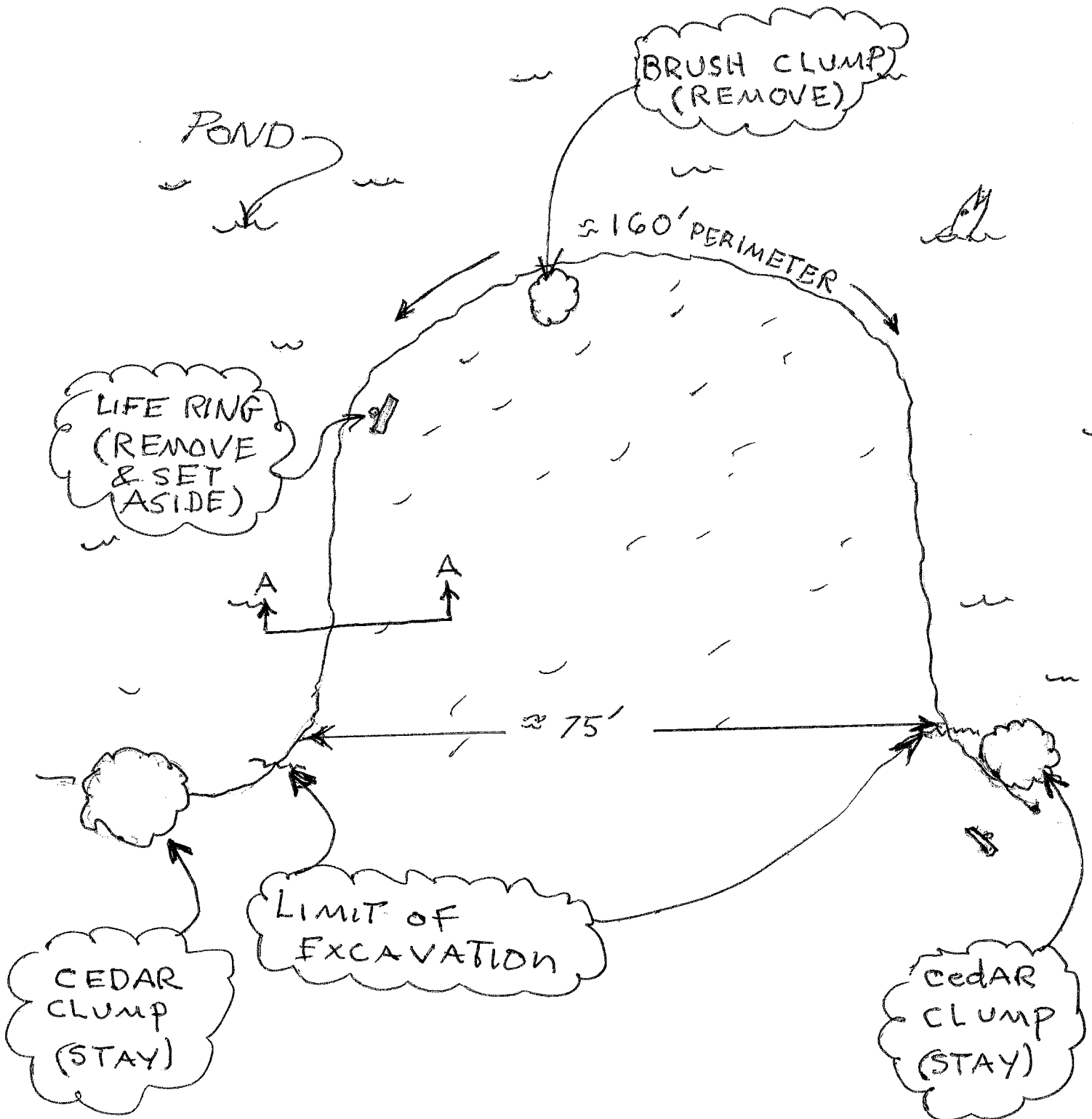


**LEELANAU COUNTY PARK...VERONICA VALLEY**  
**FISH POND WATER BANK RESTORATION**

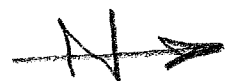
Project Description and Goal: To remove excess fill material and reconstruct about 160 linear feet of eastern peninsula to provide for safe walking and standing.

1. Remove dirt, sod, soils, etc. both above and below waterline.
2. Remove cedar post uprights and cedar post backing walls
3. Reshape slope on 1-1 gradient on land side of posts (portion that will be future underwater.
4. Create a four (4) foot wide flat walking/standing surface behind future water line, the surface which should be one (1) foot above the water line.
5. Install about three (3) inches of drain stone on the walking/standing surface.
6. Reshape soils behind the walking/standing surface on a 2-1 slope.
7. Grade, smooth and then seed disturbed soils and/or equipment ruts.
8. DEQ permits will be obtained by Leelanau County.

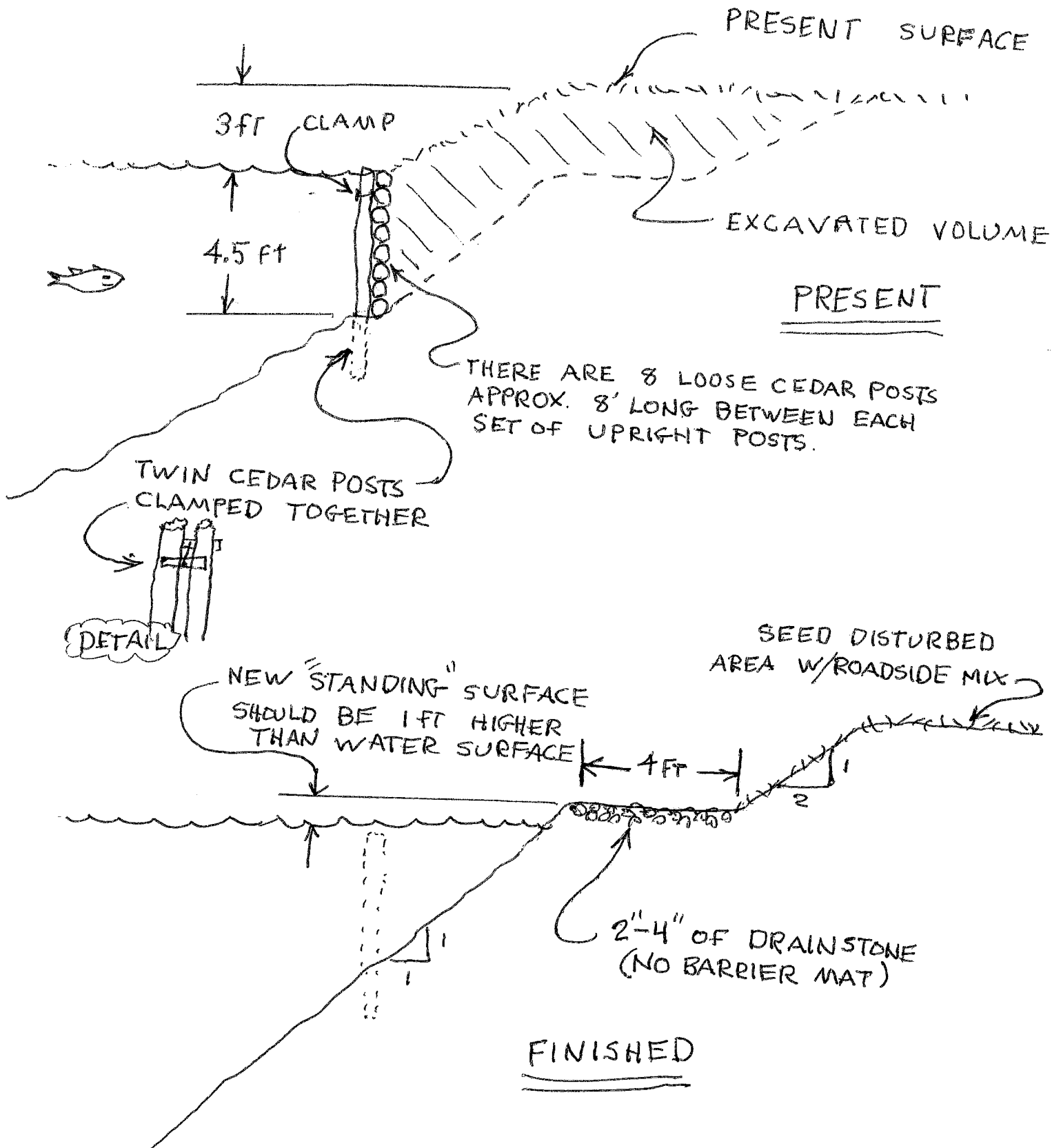
# PENINSULA TO Be Modified

Following is our proposal to clean up and paint the structural steel beams supporting the Cedar Creek bridge on Co. Rd. 651 in the village of Cedar.


**Proposal figure** **\$15,598.00**

To include:

1. Removal of surface rust and loose paint.
2. Clean steel with Dirtex rust cleaner.
3. Apply rust converter to convert any remaining rusty steel to black magnetite which is inert and will not react with moisture and oxygen.
4. Apply one coat of Universal Alkyd metal primer.
5. Apply two coats of Benjamin Moore Iron Clad oil finish paint.
6. Clean-up and removal of debris

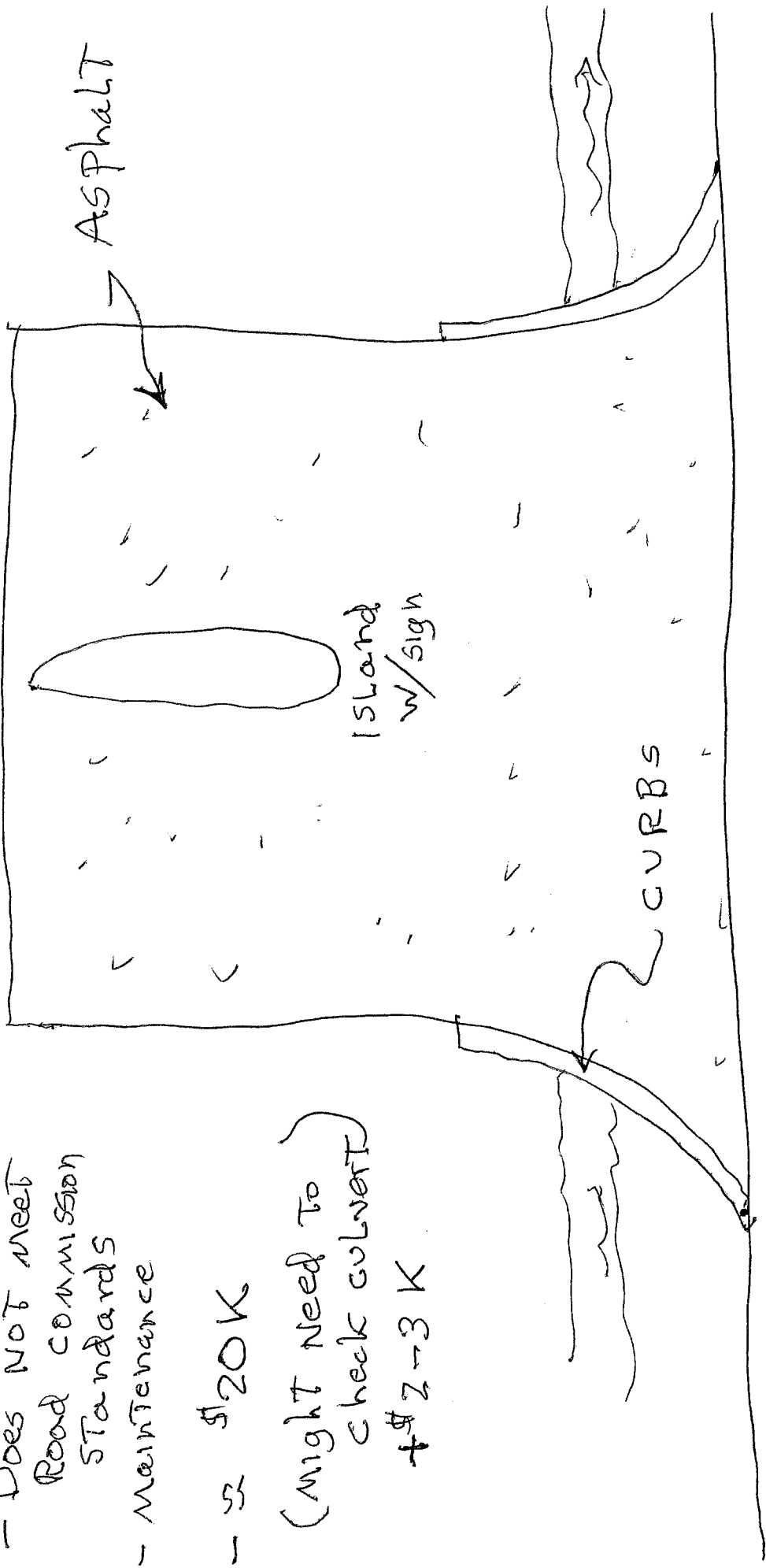
